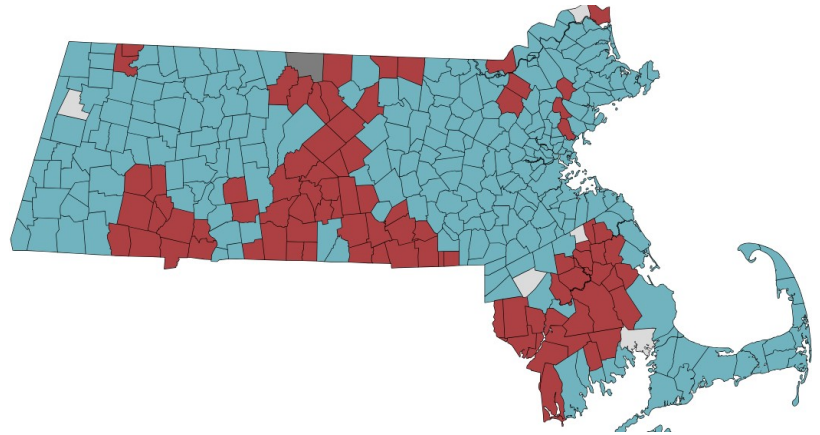


Q: Which towns voted how strongly Dem vs GOP in the presidential race?

- Randolph State Rep: Richard Wells 59% over Clinton Graham 41%
- Milton State Rep: Richard Wells 63% over Clinton Graham 37%
- Randolph Governor's Council: Tamisha Civil 74% over Francis Crimmins 26%
- Milton Governor's Council: Tamisha Civil 65% over Francis Crimmins 35%
